"I read everything I could, went to a support group in Espanola, decided we needed a support group up here, and formed one," said Jerry, who has also participated in seven Alzheimer's Memory Walks.

Jerry and Ruth Ann were married in Lyons, Kansas, on January 15, 1950. They moved to New Mexico from Lyons on January 17, 1960, and raised their two sons, Bruce and Brent, in Los Alamos.

In 2004, Jerry was named an Andrus Award nominee by the American Association of Retired Persons. He helped demolish the White Rock Senior Center to make room for the Day Out program in White Rock, and appointed himself the "unofficial sidewalk superintendent" for
