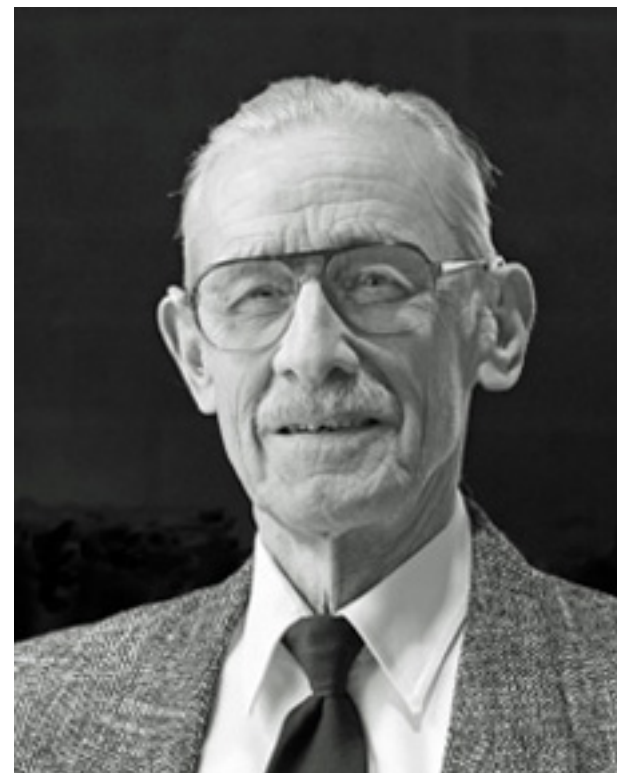


## John N. Stewart
