If you've spent any time swooshing down Pajarito Mountain (or predecessor, Sawyer Hill) in the past 60 years, you probably know Bill Chambers!

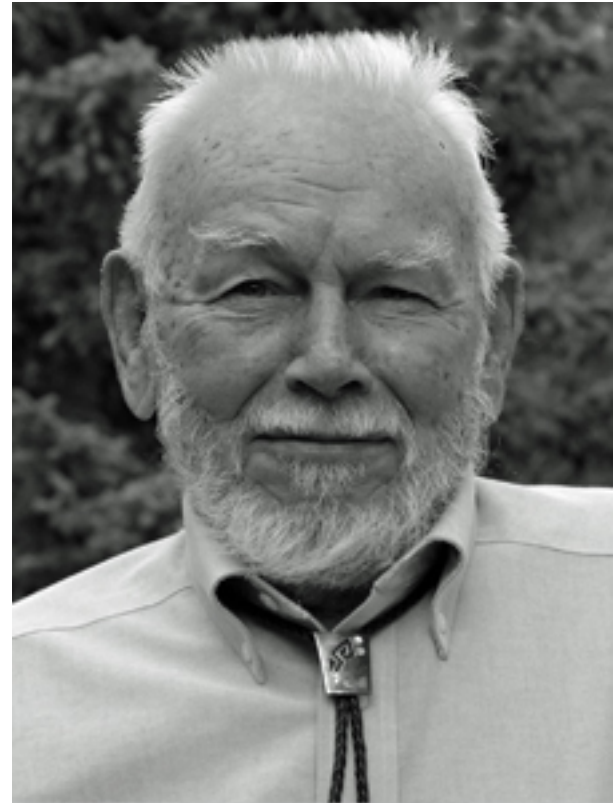
