

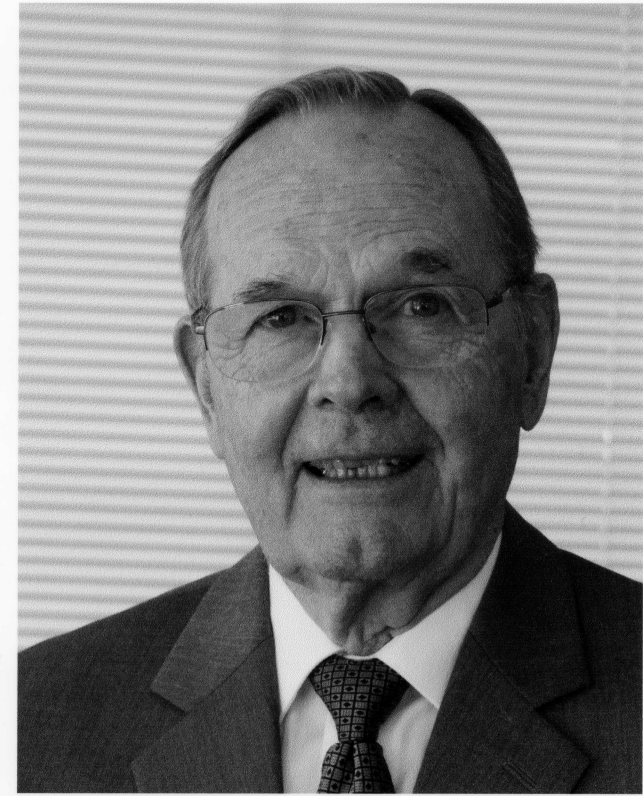
Charles “Chuck” Tallman
